

As you know, Volleyball games will look a little different for spectators this year. We want to continue to have community support, while providing the safest environment possible for our students.

1. We will open at 50% capacity according to UIL rules and will keep track of the occupancy at the gate. If your athlete has completed their competition, we kindly ask that you exit in order to provide the opportunity for other parents to watch their athletes compete later. Fans and students not competing will count towards the 50% capacity limit.
2. There will no longer be a student section on the West side of the gym, all fans will sit in the bleachers on the East side (as normal). We recommend that you socially distance in the bleachers based upon your family groups. The Visitors section will still be in the same spot. All competitors will sit in the West bleachers behind the benches.
3. The side doors, which have been unlocked in the past, will not be accessible for the public. These doors will allow the officials, coaches, and competitors to enter and exit away from the fans. All spectators will enter the gym by the main entrance.
4. According to GA-29 masks are required when the county has 20 positive cases. Shackelford County at this time has not reached that point but we encourage every effort to maintain a safe environment so that we may continue competing.

While in the gym please wash or sanitize my hands upon entering the building and periodically while in the building. Also, practice social distancing by maintaining at least six feet of separation from others. If such distancing is not feasible, implement measures such as face covering, hand hygiene, cough etiquette, cleanliness/sanitation
