Domain 1

Domain 2

There was no GROWTH COMPONENT in 2021 because of no testing in 2020. Growth counted 50% of total score in 2019 for Elementary Campuses. It is not calculated in Secondary Campuses.

Domain 3

Closing the gaps uses disaggregated data to demonstrate differentials among ethnic groups, socioeconomic backgrounds and other factors. The indicators included in this domain, as well as the domain's construction align the state accountability system with the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). These Targets are set by the state and are based on the MEETS category only in READING/ELA and MATH.

Normally, for Elementary school Domain 1 and 2 go in with Academic Achievement for an overall score for a rating, so basically all Elementary scores are based on growth and STAAR performance. Secondary and District Ratings are based on Academic Achievement, Multi-Year Graduation Rate (Federal) and College, Career and Military Readiness (CCMR).
