COVID-19 Guidelines**

Seating

Home Seating Capacity @ 50%: 100

Visitor Seating Capacity @ 50%: 100

Passes Accepted: District 10AA, Albany Season Pass

Season Passes @ AISD Administration Office

Ticket Prices: Main Gym – Adults \$4, Students \$2
or
Season Passes \$60.00/Individual (good for **VARSITY HOME** games only)
Auxiliary Gym – All Tickets \$2
Junior High – All Tickets \$2

Seating: Home spectators will sit in sections A & B
Visiting spectators will sit in Sections C & D
Visiting players/coaches sit behind bench

Gym Use: Non-District and Varsity District Games will be played in the Main Gym
JV District Games will be played in the Auxiliary Gym
JH Games will all be played in the Main Gym

Dressing Rooms: Visiting Dressing Rooms are located in the Auxiliary Gym (will be labeled)

Bus Parking: Visiting Buses will park behind the Main Gym

During A Game

- Water buckets will be provided for teams
- Hand sanitizer will be available at the scorer's table
- Teams will be provided with warm-up balls
- Masks must be worn while on the bench
- No handshakes between players, refs, or coaches before or after the game

COVID-19 PROCEDURES/POLICIES

Health Screening Prior to Entry

- Spectators will be required to self-screen for COVID-19 symptoms prior to entrance into the facility.
- Any individuals who are confirmed to have, suspected of having, are experiencing symptoms of, or have been in close contact with an individual who has been confirmed to have COVID-19 should NOT enter the facility.

Face-Coverings

- In compliance with Governor Abbott's Executive Order GA-29, all school employees, parents, visitors and students ten years of age or older MUST wear face coverings or face shields upon entry to an area where UIL activities are being conducted and when not actively practicing or participating in the contest.
- Shackelford County is currently EXEMPT from this requirement.
- Face-coverings include non-medical grade disposable face masks, cloth face coverings (over the nose and mouth), or full-face shields to protect eyes, nose, and mouth.

Social Distancing

- Spectators are asked to practice social distancing while in the gyms and concession areas.
- Groups should maintain at least six feet of distance from other groups at all times, including the process of admission and seating. A group is defined as no more than 10 people including the members of the household and those persons who traveled together to the facility.

Discontinuation of Contest

- We respect that it is a privilege to have this competition with fans in the stands. In order for these competitions to continue, we must follow the orders and expectations put in place to protect the health and safety of all. As responsible citizens of Texas, it is our responsibility to comply with those requirements.
- If you choose to not comply with the defined expectations, you will be required to exit the gym immediately.

Sportsmanship

- Albany ISD promotes good sportsmanship by student-athletes, coaches, and spectators. We request your cooperation by supporting the participants and officials in a positive manner.
- Profanity, racial or sexist comments, or other intimidating actions directed at officials, student-athletes, coaches, team representative or fellow spectators will not be tolerated and are grounds for removal from the site of competition.

Concession Area

- Patrons are asked to practice proper social distancing and refrain from gathering in large groups.
- Face-coverings are required when not eating or drinking. (Shackelford County is EXEMPT from this requirement at this time.)
- Students and/or children are not permitted in the concession area without an adult. No playing, running, or congregating in the concession area.
