Purpose of DIC

The District Improvement Committee's (DIC) primary purpose is to advise the district administration in the planning, operating, supervising, and evaluating of the District's educational program.

The duties of the DIC include:

- Attend meetings and be a willing participant.
- Be involved in establishing and reviewing the District's educational plans, goals, performance objectives, and major classroom instructional programs.
- Addressing all pertinent federal planning requirements.
- Assisting the district administration annually in preparing, reviewing and revising the District Improvement Plan (DIP).
- Holding one public meeting annually, after receipt of the District level performance report, to discuss District performance and objectives.
- Advise District staff regarding student policies.

The DIC meets 4 times a year. Nominations for new members should be submitted to the Superintendent or Director of Student Services by the August of each school year.
