

NSES Grading Policy **COVID19 Distance Learning Policy**

During the COVID19 Pandemic, all schools across Texas have moved to a distance learning platform. Albany ISD has adjusted our grading policy for the final six weeks accordingly and will continue to take grades during this time. If you or your child have any questions, please reach out to the classroom teacher.

Expectation of hours of work per day.

Pre-K - Kindergarten: 30 minutes a day (For all Subjects)

1st - 2nd Grade: 0:45-1:00 hour per day (For all Subjects)

3rd - 6th Grade: 1:00-1:30 hours per day (For all Subjects)

Number of graded assignments per Six Weeks

Pre-K - Kindergarten: (One Packet Per Week)

1st - 2nd Grade: (One Packet Per Week)

3rd - 6th Grade: 8 Per Subject

Grades Pre-K - 2nd Grade

Students will be graded on a Pass/Fail scale.

Pass (P) = (Numerical Grade = 90)

Fail (F) = (Numerical Grade = 70)

3rd Grade - 6th Grade

Students will continue to receive grades in 4 core subjects. (Math / Reading / Science / S.S.) Teachers will enter a minimum of 8 graded assignments per core subject each six weeks. In gradebook, teachers must enter the assigned date as well as the due date of each assignment.

Grades are a requirement for all core subjects. Students who do not submit assignments will receive a zero in the gradebook and are at risk of failing for both the six weeks, and/or the spring semester. If a student fails, the Grade Placement Committee (GPC) will meet to discuss student options including summer school and/or grade retention.

Elective classes will continue to send content home but will receive an E for exempt in the gradebook.
