SEMESTER TEST EXEMPTION POLICY

Each semester Students are required to take <u>2 different core</u> exams (English, Math, Science, Social Studies) regardless of exemption status.

Core Course Exam Requirements:

All students must take the 4 core course exams per year (Math, Science, Social Studies, English), different 2 each semester.

- * Dual credit classes, your finals are based on the professor.
- ** Juniors and Sophomores taking 1 core dual credit course have to take one other core exam.
- *** Seniors taking Dual Credit courses do not have to take other subjects finals if they are exempt and taking at least two finals for their dual credit course.

If a student meets the following criteria, he/she may be exempt from the allowable exams:

- 1. 0-1 absences an 80 or above average per class.
- 2. 2 absences an 85 or above average per class.
- 3. 3 absences a 90 or above average per class.
- 4. 4 or more absences the student must take all exams.

An absence is non-attendance during the class period. Exceptions are as follows;

- Co-curricular and Extra-curricular activities under the direction of a professional staff member.
- 2. Recurring medical appointments for a chronic condition and medical appointments with specialists, as deemed appropriate by the ARD committee.
- 3. Any doctors note that specifies the student needs to stay out of school (i.e., 72 hours fever free).
- 4. Visits to the driver's license office.

If a student receives 3 tardies in that period, that will result in one absence in regards to exemption purposes.

If a student has any *unexcused* absence, they will not be exempt for that course.

** Any on-campus (ISS), Saturday School, corporal punishment, out of school suspension, or AEP will disqualify a student from exemption status in all classes.

On final exam days if a student is exempt the whole day, they must sign in at the office by 9:00 am.

A teacher has the authority to override the exemption policy if needed for their subject taught.
